What Is Scrip?

Scrip means “substitute money” in the form of gift cards or gift certificates. You can use the gift cards/certificates to purchase everyday needs like food, gas, and clothing besides presenting as gifts. Each purchase earns revenue for the TTA Parent Partner Organization (PPO) or TPS Robotics student, anywhere from 2% to 22%.

Scrip is "shopping cart fundraising"

Fundraising revenue is made by families through regular household purchases they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with scrip.

Can scrip be used to pay store credit card balances?

Some merchants allow this if the payment is made at the store, and if not paid in full, that the minimum monthly payment is still mailed. Visit <http://www.nosa.us/> (click on the NOSA icon) for a list of all merchants and their scrip restrictions under “Merchant Info.

Ordering Process and Guidelines

Send in orders to TTA’s main office by Friday, 3 p.m. Make checks or money order to **TPS Robotics**. Pick up the following Friday at 3:45- 4 p.m. via the person specified on the form; picture ID required and signature upon receipt of order.

Checks returned for non-sufficient funds will incur a \$38 fee. Verify order and report discrepancies to Kathy Martin within 48 hours. Scrip is the same as cash so handle accordingly; TTA PPO and TPS Robotics will not be responsible for scrip that is lost, stolen, or misplaced when given to the person designated to pick up order and while in your possession.
